



A GUIDE TO UNDERSTANDING WHAT TO DO WHEN SOMEONE DIES.

1: Have your loved one pronounced dead.

In the Event your love one dies at home, contact the Police and the Doctor immediately. If your love one dies at the hospital this will be handled by a Medical doctor there.

2: Secure The Medical Certificate

This will be provided by the doctor who pronounced the body

3: Secure The Burial Order

In order to receive the Burial Order, the Medical Certificate must be presented to the Registrar General

4: Make Funeral Arrangements

- (a) Meet with a Funeral Home representative and make necessary arrangements
- (b) Identify a church of choice and make necessary arrangements
- (c) Provide the clothing for the deceased

5: Cremation Documents (IF APPLICABLE)

Provided by the Funeral Home

6: Make Payments

Be sure to secure funding at least 3 days before the service

7. Funeral Service

8. Secure The Death Certificate

The signed Burial Order should be taken back to the Registrar General where a Death Certificate will be presented.

9. File for NIS Benefits
